Public access to the Pye Flatts meadows is not permitted however free guided walks are available from the owner between May and July.

These are sponsored by Natural England under the educational access scheme. They normally last about two hours with a minimum of six persons, who will also receive a free information booklet about the meadow and its species.

The meadows were recently featured on the Royal Geographical Society publication for Hoylandswaine in their Discover Britain series. This is viewable on their website. Remember free roaming on the meadow is not permitted March / August.
